The school calendar year is from April to March. The working hours are from 8.40 am to 3.35 pm. There are eight learning periods of 40 minutes duration every day. Saturdays are working days except second Saturdays. Changes may happen with prior notice.

### **Admission**

Admission to the school is restricted by certain policies of the management and by the condition of age, ability and conduct. Children are admitted in the school for classes KG-I to XI. The minimum age for admission of KG-I is Four years, as on 31<sup>st</sup> May. It is mandatory that the student should attend an entrance test. Application form has to be dully filled up and submitted in the school office before the entrance test. Information about the admission process will be intimated over the phone. New admission will be purely based on merit. Following documents in original must be produced at the time of admission and photo copy of the same should be submitted in the school office.

### **Fee Regulations**

- School fees and bus fees can be paid in three instalments as mentioned below
  - First Installment : On or before April 10<sup>th</sup>
  - Second Installment : On or before September 10<sup>th</sup>
  - Third Installment : On or before December 10<sup>th</sup>
- In case of non payment of fees by due date, fine of Rs.10/- per working day shall be collected.
- Pupils will not be permitted to attend their tests / examinations unless all fees due are paid to date.
- Fees once paid will not be refunded.
- Hall tickets will be issued to the students who have cleared their dues atleast a week before the examination.

### **Attendance**

- Maintain a minimum of 90% attendance.
- Produce a Doctor certificate for absence of more than three days due to sickness.
- Absence of a student on an examination day will be considered as leave and they will not be able to re-write the examination.

- Report every breakage or loss immediately to the teacher incharge.

### **School Transport**

- Be punctual to bus stop to board the bus on time.
- Do not stand in the moving bus and be always seated.
- Do not quarrel and make noise.
- Do not put your hands and head outside the window of the bus.
- Do not get down in any other stop other than yours.
- Students who cause damage to the bus will have to pay the penalty.
- The school will not provide alternative transport facilities to students who miss the bus.
- Students are not allowed to have snacks in the school bus.
- Students availing school transport must follow all disciplinary instructions in the bus. They must sit on designated seat, not walk in the buses or create noise that can divert attention of the driver. Any violation may result in immediate suspension of the transport facility.

### **Health and Hygiene**

- Use the toilets and wash areas with care.
- Wash hands before and after eating, after using toilet and after playing.
- Use spoon while eating food and napkin to clean hands after wash.
- Do not bring junk food or snacks to school.
- Do not attend school when affected by contagious diseases.
- Undergo first aid in the school when injured during playing a game or due to unexpected events.

## Viva Voce

Viva voce occurs before the written final exams (Term-II) to promote their confidence and it helps them to prepare effectively for the final exams. It's an opportunity for the examiner to evaluate the depth of knowledge of the subject.

## Exam Attendance

"Exam attendance is mandatory. Students must be present for the exams unless there is an emergency or illness. Leave will be granted only in exceptional circumstances."

## Withdrawal

- The students those who want to apply for T.C. should apply on or before 28<sup>th</sup> Feb. If it goes beyond the date mentioned they have to pay the first term fee, uniform and book fee for the next academic year.
- If a child has to be withdrawn from the school, parents are requested to give one calendar month notice in written format.
- Application for a Transfer Certificate should be given in written format to the Principal by the parent one month in advance.
- T.C will be issued only after all the dues are settled.

- If the head of the institution finds any student's performance unsatisfactory and orders withdrawal of such student, it is obligatory on the part of the parent to withdraw the student.

### **Amendments of Rules**

The Principal and management has the right to introduce new rules, amend or change these rules and regulations in case of exigencies and in furtherance of the aims and objectives of the managing society and the school as and when the necessity arises.

### **Extracurricular Activities (ECA)**

Extracurricular activities constitute an important part of educational orientation in our school. Therefore, students are expected to participate actively in any one of the ECA. Each one will get ample of opportunities to explore, develop and exhibit all their traits. Dance, Chess, Karate, Table tennis, Football, Basket Ball, Skating, Keyboard, Silambam, Swimming, Takewondo, Archery, Drawing, Handwriting and Robotics.

Guides and scouts movement, School band and school choir are other extra curricular activities in which our students are trained regularly.

### **Physical Education**

Activities included in the PET Program are designed to promote physical fitness and more importantly, to teach students adherence to the rules of sports. Coaching in various indoor & outdoor sports and Athletic events are provided at school by trained instructor to excel them in both individual as well as team performances. As a part of curriculum it is mandatory that every student should participate in physical education programme.

### **House System**

Healthy competition is the keyword to success. Therefore, students are grouped in four different houses and every year the houses are named differently. Each house has a captain, vice captain and a house parent. House wise competitions are conducted to create a sense of belonging and to foster team spirit. Results of all such competitions are graded and awarded.

### **Cultural and Sports Competition**

All literary, Cultural and Sports competitions will be conducted in different categories on sports day and cultural fest. Only the winner can participate at interschool competitions. Hence, if two get first prize at school competition, another selection will be held to select the best one.

The talents and skills of students are identified and encouraged to participate in inter - school / district / state / national level competitions from school. They will have to bear the expense like registration fee, food, transportation etc.

**Annual Day Celebration:**

- Annual day is celebrated every year.
- Students will be provided with ample opportunities to stage programme.
- An amount will be collected from each student towards the general expense of the Annual Day.
- All students are expected to participate in it.

**Co-operation of Parents**

- Prime importance is given to building a sound character in students.
- The co-operation of all parents is expected in ensuring the students regular and punctual attendance, good general behavior and execution of home work.
- Send the child in neat uniform and maintain good personal hygiene.
- Ensure that the child has a minimum of 90% attendance.
- Empower children to be discreet, alert and cautious in all interactions with strangers.
- Ensure the school bag is packed according to the timetable.
- Check the school diary regularly.
- Be regular in payment of fees.
- Encourage the child's participation in co-curricular events and programmes.
- Avoid usage of abusive language to the child.
- Send the child punctually to the bus stop to board the bus on time.
- Communicate to the class teacher / concerned subject teacher through school diary if you require.
- Avoid contacting teachers on their personal mobile phones and try to meet them in person by setting up a meeting time at school.
- During school hours parents are not allowed to see their wards. Attend PTA meetings without fail to know about the child's progress.

**General Rules of Discipline**

- An orderly student community is the hallmark of our school. For this an atmosphere of silence should be maintained by everyone during working hours in class rooms, staffrooms and office.
- The handbook is issued to every student at the beginning of the year. It should be kept neat and tidy all through the year. Students are not allowed to write anything in it except as directed in the respective pages.

- Hence if it is lost a new one should be collected on payment from the office only after getting the special permission of the Principal. It is an important year – long career document of each and every student.
- The prescribed school uniform should be worn on all occasions. The uniform should be washed and ironed. Any violation of uniform will be noticed and punished. Short tights is compulsory for girls from grade 3 onwards. Pupils must observe personal hygiene and cleanliness. The boys should have proper hair cut. Girls must plait their hair on both the sides. Gold or costly ornaments are not permissible.
- Pupils are allowed to wear the wrist watch only from Grade: V onwards.
- Wear a fresh pair of socks every day. Nails should be cut short and kept clean.
- As English is the medium of instruction, the students are always expected to converse only in English, as long as they represent the school.
- No pupil shall leave his / her class room during working hours without the permission of teachers.
- Pupils shall attend the class punctually with their lessons and homework well-prepared.
- Every pupil shall respectfully greet the teachers on his / her first meeting on the school premises.
- When the teacher enters the classroom, the pupils shall rise and remain standing till they are asked to sit. Students must reach school 5 minutes before the scheduled time. Late comers will be fined Rs. 20. All students must attend morning assembly. Serious action will be taken against the students present in the school but missing from the morning assembly.
- No pupil is allowed to leave the school premises during school hours without the permission of the Principal.
- Pupils are not to loiter in the school premises during class hours. Whenever they have to move to the library, laboratory, auditorium, play ground etc. they should do so in an orderly manner, not disturbing neighbouring classes.
- In case the students have to go home before the final bell the student can move only with the parent / guardian. A gate pass will be filled in, signed by the parent and the school authorities. However prior permission from the principal has to be obtained.
- Students should see that no damage is done to school property. They should not write on or disfigure the library books. Any damage caused inadvertently or otherwise should be brought to the notice of the Principal. Those who cause damage will be liable to repair the same at their own expense.
- Inattentiveness, indifference to study, discourtesy towards any member of the staff or any act which affects the discipline and tone of the school will be seriously viewed and in extreme cases they are sufficient reasons for dismissal from school. Immorality,

grave insubordination, contempt for authority, willful damage to school property, malpractice in examinations, etc. are sufficient reasons for immediate dismissal.

- Students are prohibited from bringing cell phones, any electronic gadgets and two wheelers to the school campus.
- Students taking leave should intimate the same to the class incharge and should fill the leave notification in the diary and it must be signed by the parents when he or she returns.
- No pupil shall enter the school premises if he / she is suffering from any contagious disease.
- The institution will not be responsible for injury suffered during any of the school activities, picnics or excursions. The management, however, assures to take all possible precautions and care, in any eventuality.
- Pupils are to bear in mind the instructions given through classes and especially through moral science. Regularity, implicit obedience and cleanliness are virtues that must be inculcated in children from the very beginning.
- Objectionable behavior even outside school will make them liable to disciplinary action. Ignorance of rules will not be accepted as an excuse.
